

# WARRANTY

Interstate Batteries recommends charging and retesting a battery before replacing it.

**\* The 30-month and 24-month warranties apply on batteries purchased in February 2006 and later. Before February 2006, these batteries have an 18-month free-replacement warranty.**

Interstate Battery System of America, Inc. (IBSA) warrants only to the original purchaser that: (1) this battery is free of defects in material and workmanship for the number of months indicated on the label, and (2) before installation or use, the state of charge of this battery has been maintained at a level equal to or greater than the minimum level considered necessary under industry standards for batteries to perform effectively upon their use or installation. If adjustment is necessary due to (1) or (2) above and the battery is NOT MERELY DISCHARGED after installation or use, then upon return of the battery to an authorized dealer, it will be replaced free of charge (except for taxes and legislatively imposed fees, where applicable) according to these free-replacement periods from the date of original purchase:

- 30 months\* for batteries with a total warranty of 85 months
- 24 months\* for batteries with a total warranty of 75 months
- 18 months for batteries with (a) a total warranty of 65 months, (b) part numbers C24-XHD, C24F-XHD, C27-XHD, C27F-XHD, C50-VHD, C65-XHD, C75DT-XHD, C74-XHD, C78DT-XHD, and (c) group sizes 29H and 31
- 12 months for marine batteries HD24-DP, 24M-HD, 24M-RD, 24M-XHD, SRM-24, SRM-27, SRM-27B, SRM-29
- 6 months for all other batteries

If a passenger car battery is used in a diesel vehicle (not including passenger automobiles), commercial service, truck over one ton, marine service, recreational vehicle, lawn tractor, snowmobile, etc., the warranty is reduced to a free-replacement period of six months and a pro-rata warranty period one half the length of that indicated on the battery label.

Warranty terms are subject to change. For specific warranty terms and restrictions, please see the warranty attached to the battery purchased. The warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights that may vary from state to state.
